

# Race Conditions - Australasian Arabian Racing Club Inc.

## AARC Purebred Arabian Open Race

**STANDARD SET WEIGHTS & Penalties** for Purebred Arabians 3yo 6mths & over

**FIELD CAPACITY:** Maximum 10 Starters & 2 Emergencies

**Prize Money:** 1<sup>st</sup> 50%, 2<sup>nd</sup> 25%, 3<sup>rd</sup> 12.5%, 4<sup>th</sup> 7.5%, 5<sup>th</sup> 5.0%

**NOMINATIONS OPEN:** at least 2 weeks before the event

**NOMINATION FEE: \$50**

**ACCEPTANCE FEE: \$70**

**JOCKEY FEE: \$100** – as the Jockey will be employed for the race by AARC, and is covered by our WorkCover, this fee will be paid to the Jockey at the end of the race.

**NOMINATIONS:** (\$50) close 7 days before the race (race on Saturday, nominations 11:59pm previous Saturday). All entry & acceptances must be forwarded by the nominator or agent to AARC, 773 Kholo Rd, Kholo, Queensland 4306, or be completed online

**FINAL ACCEPTANCE:** (\$70 plus 0.5% prize money levy) close 12.00 noon, 4 days before the race (race on Saturday, acceptances noon previous Tuesday)

NB: Any horse for which declaration has not been received at closing time will be automatically withdrawn.

**JOCKEY NOTIFICATION:** (\$100) close 11:59pm, 4 days before the race

**WEIGHTS:** Novice, Maiden and Class 1 horses will be rated by section 1 (Base Weights) of the AARC Weights document. The rest of the field will be rated by all 4 sections of the AARC Weights document (Base Weights, Winning Penalties, Margin Penalties and Weight Deductions).

**RACE CONDITIONS:** All horses MUST be eligible under the conditions set out by the Australasian Arabian Racing Club Inc. (AARC). For all registered horses regardless of their record. The field (maximum 10 with provision for 2 emergencies) will be determined by the AARC Committee at final acceptance time.

**BALLOTING:** Horses to be eliminated in the following order:

1. Horses which have received the lowest average prize money per start over their last 6 starts to be eliminated in ascending order. If equal then:
2. Horses which have the lowest career average prize money per start to be eliminated in ascending order. If equal then;

3. Horses to be eliminated by lot. or:
4. A random draw conducted by 2 AARC Representatives, where horses are drawn at random until the field capacity is reached, including emergencies.

The Barrier Draw will be conducted in conjunction with the field selection.

**COMMITTEE DISCRETION:** The Committee of AARC may at its discretion:

1. Exclude any horse or horses from the race, irrespective of whether or not the field limit of 10 horses and 2 emergencies ("the field") as at final acceptance time shall be reached;
2. Exempt any horse or horses;
3. Select the field to compete in the race with the assistance of an advisory panel including Racing Director, Racing Operations & Chief Handicapper and in so doing have regard to but not be bound by the race conditions set out above

**GENERAL CONDITIONS:**

1. All Stallions must be controlled by 2 handlers
2. Nominations will only be accepted from trainers who are financial
3. PRIZEMONEY DISTRIBUTION: With regard to horses earning prize money for being placed 1st to 5th inclusive, respective prize monies payable shall be distributed as follows: Owner - 85%; Trainer - 15%
4. In the event of a horse being eliminated at final declaration, only the final acceptance fee and Jockey fee shall be refunded.
5. Entries for the above race shall only be received on condition that the Rules of Racing and Regulations of AARC now or hereafter in force shall be binding in all respects.
6. The Committee reserves the right to make from time to time any alteration or modification to the conditions governing the race, this may also include combining races and to alter the date and time for receiving entries, payments and declarations.
7. All currency amounts quoted are in Australian dollars (\$AUD).
8. The Prize Money for all sponsored races will be paid out upon receipt of payment from the sponsor.
